NOTICE OF VACANCIES

The Cherokee County Board of Supervisors is taking applications for various county board and commission appointments for the 2019/2020 fiscal year. Cherokee County appreciates diversity in these appointments and welcomes all applicants at least 18 years of age. Terms and dates of appointments vary. These are unpaid positions. A brief description follows:

Veterans Affairs Commission:

Members of the five-person Veterans Affairs Commission must be veterans, preferably of different wars. The commission is responsible for approving payments for relief provided to veterans by office staff. Office staff is supervised by the commission. Meetings are held monthly. Three-year term.

Cherokee County Civil Service Commission:

The Civil Service Commission is created and governed by Iowa Code Chapter 341A with duties pertaining to Civil Service for Deputy County Sheriffs. The Commission certifies lists for appointment to covered positions and hears employee appeals on promotions, demotions, suspensions and dismissals. Six-year term.
