NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR SALE OF TAX SALE CERTIFICATES ON REAL ESTATE BY CHEROKEE COUNTY, IOWA

Persons wishing to make written comments may do so by submitting them to the Cherokee County Auditor no later than 8:30 A.M. on Tuesday, the 27th day of November, 2018. Persons wishing to make oral comments may do so at the public hearing at the time and place referenced above.

The Board of Supervisors will also consider bids from interested parties to purchase the tax sale certificates on real estate above described. Persons interested in making an offer to purchase the tax sale certificates on the above described real estate may do so by submitting their bid to the Cherokee County Auditor at the Cherokee County Courthouse in a sealed envelope marked "Bid for Tax Sale Certificates on Irr Co's Addition property" no later than 8:30 A.M. on Tuesday, the 27th day of November, 2018. Prospective buyers should take into consideration the total amount of taxes and costs due on the property in determining the amount of their bids. The taxes and costs due as of October, 2018, are in the amount of \$11,733.60. The Bids will be opened and read aloud by the Board of Supervisors in the Board of Supervisors' Room at the Cherokee County Courthouse after the public hearing has been completed on the Resolution of Desire to Sell and Assign Tax Sale Certificates for Real Property. Buyer shall be responsible for all costs associated with the transfer/assignment of the tax sale certificates.

The Board of Supervisors reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any formalities.
