RESOLUTION NO. 18-16

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE CLERK TO PUBLISH NOTICE OF HEARING ON THE PROPOSED CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMENDING CHAPTER 41.12 "FIREWORKS PERMIT" AURELIA, IOWA."

WHEREAS, there has been on file in the office of the City Clerk for public inspection an official copy of the proposed "CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF AURELIA, IOWA 1999."

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that a public hearing thereon will be held in the Aurelia Council Chambers on the November 19, 2018, at 6:30 o'clock p.m., at which time and place the Council will consider arguments for or against the adoption of the proposed CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMENDING CHAPTER 41.12 "FIREWORKS PERMIT" AURELIA, IOWA." CHAPTER 41.12(3): CONSUMER

FIREWORKS

A. It is unlawful for any person to use or explode consumer fireworks on days other than June 28 through July 6 and December 31 of each year, all dates inclusive.

B. It is unlawful for any person to use or explode consumer fireworks at times other than between the hours of 9:00 am and 10:00 p.m., except that on the following dates consumer fireworks shall not be used at times other than between the hours specified:

1. Between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. on July 4 and between the hours of 9:00 am and 10:00 pm on Fridays and Saturdays falling within the days of June 28 through July 6.
2. Between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. on De-

ember 31.

C. It is unlawful for any person to use consumer fireworks on real property other than that person's real property or on the real property of a person who has consented to the use of consumer fireworks on that property.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk be authorized and directed to be published a notice of such hearing one time not less than seven (7) days nor more than (20) days prior to the date herein established for hearing as by law provided.
