## City of Aurelia

**MARCH 4, 2019**

The Aurelia City Council met in special session on March 4, 2019. Mayor Suhr brought meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. with roll call as follows:

Council Members Present: Redig, Nelson, Stroud, Johnson, Baker, Suhr.

Absent:

Also Present: Messerole.

Roman made motion to open Public Hearing to approve FY2019-20 Budget, second by Nelson. Roll Call vote "aye" Nelson, Johnson, Stroud, Baker, Redig; "nay" none. Motion carried.

Nelson made motion to donate \$100.00 to Alta-Aurelia Warriors' After Prom, second by Johnson. All members present voting "aye," motion carried.

Four bids for asbestos removal from 102 E. 1<sup>st</sup> Street (Old Locker) and 115 Myrtle Street (Petty Building) were discussed. EPS Environmental Property

Solutions, Urbandale, IA-\$5,825.00; Site Services, Algona, IA-\$9,777.00; ESA Earth Services & Abatement, Des Moines, IA-\$11,875.00; Wheeler Contracting, Omaha, NE-\$12,700.00. After further discussion, Redig made motion to approve EPS Environmental Property Solutions' bid of \$5,825.00 for asbestos removal of both buildings, second by Baker. All members present voting "aye," motion carried.

Wage contribution to Municipal Electric for Deputy Clerk position was discussed. After further discussion, Redig made motion to contribute \$28,830.81 to Municipal Electric, second by Stroud. All members present voting "aye," motion carried.

Personnel Policy/Office Procedures employee handbook was tabled until March 18, 2019, regular meeting.

Baker made motion to close Public Hearing to approve FY2019-20 Budget,

second by Johnson. Roll Call vote "aye:" Redig, Baker, Stroud, Nelson, Johnson; "nay" none. Motion carried.

Redig made motion to approve Resolution #19-01 "Resolution Adopting Budget and Certificate of City Taxes for Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2020," second by Baker. Roll call vote "aye" Nelson, Johnson, Baker, Stroud, Redig; "nay" none. Motion carried. Total tax levy of \$12.134 per \$1,000 valuation on regular property, same as last year; budgeted revenues of \$1,575,367 and budgeted expenditures of \$1,563,087. The City of Aurelia did not receive any verbal or written protests from the public.

There being no more business to discuss, meeting was adjourned.
