representatives from Aurelia Day Care, appeared before Council for an annual update. Day Care currently has 69 children enrolled and several on a waiting list. After further discussion, Nelson made motion to donate \$10,000.00 to Aurelia Day Care, second by Johnson. All members present voting "aye;" motion carried.

Public Works Report was reviewed. Street sweeping; planted 6 trees in park; fall lagoon discharge; picked up plow/sander truck; pumped water out of pool. Johnson requested the current "Welcome" banners come down.

A. 417 E. 3<sup>rd</sup> Street has been demolished, total costs incurred to date \$4,669.51.

B. Sealed bids for 1988 Chevrolet Kodiak Diesel truck were opened. Bid from Tom Mummert in amount of \$3,050; and bid from Mel Kruse in amount of \$1,500. After further discussion, Nelson made motion to approve sale of 1988 Chevrolet Kodiak Diesel truck to Tom Mummert for \$3,050; second by Baker. All members present voting "aye;" motion carried.

C. Sangwin discussed with Council cleaning approximately 15 blocks of sewer lines, spending around \$6,000. Council agreed this would be regular preventive maintenance.

Police Report was reviewed. "What You Don't See" trailer will be in Aurelia Friday, October 19, 2018, at Aurelia School.

Baker made motion to approve Resolution #18-16 "Fireworks Ordinance," and set public hearing for November 19, 2018, second by Stroud. Roll call vote "aye," Stroud, Baker, Johnson; "nay," Nelson. Motion carried 3-1. Redig Absent.

Johnson made motion to approve Resolution #18-18 "Authorizing 28E Agreement with Marcus, Iowa, Regarding Law Enforcement Services", second by Baker. Roll call vote "aye" Johnson, Baker, Stroud, Nelson; "nay" none. Motion carried. Redig absent.

Clerk's Report was reviewed.

Baker made motion to approve renewal of liquor license for Aurelia Golf Club, second by Nelson. All members present voting "aye;" motion carried.

Renewal of current Wellmark Blue Cross & Blue Shield Health Insurance was discussed. After further discussion, Nelson made motion to approve renewal of Wellmark Blue Cross & Blue Shield, Plan Enhanced Blue 2000, second by Baker. All members present voting "aye;" motion carried.

No Landfill report was given. There being no further business to discuss, meeting was adjourned.
