The Board of Directors of the Alta-Aurelia Community School District met in regular session on December 11, 2018, in Room 7 at the Alta-Aurelia Middle School. President Brad Rohwer called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. Board members present: Jen Kaskey, Gigi Nelson, Brad Rohwer, Nicky Sleezer and Jon Turnquist. Absent: Katie Meyer and Jodi Theisen. Others present: Lynn Evans, Superintendent; Tom Ryherd, Stacy Mueller and Jeannie Henningsen, Principals; and Vicki Kolpin, Board Secretary. Also attending: four staff members, one student and his parent, four citizens from the community and two members of the press.

Motion by Sleezer second by Turnquist to approve the agenda, adding a report from Aiden Freese. Roll call vote: Aye: Sleezer, Turnquist, Kaskey, Nelson, Rohwer. Nay: None. Adopted.

Motion by Kaskey, second by Turnquist to approve the minutes from the session held November 13, 2018. Roll call vote: Aye: Turnquist, Kaskey, Nelson, Sleezer, Turnquist. Aye: All. Nay: None. Adopted.

The board recognized the Dance Team for placing first in the Hoopla category at state competition and those football players who received all-state honors and the coaches for being named District Coaches of the year.

Aiden Freese updated the group on his percussion storage project. Installation of the cabinets is scheduled for December 15.

Motion by Kaskey, second by Sleezer to approve the application for Modified Allowable Growth for Dropout Prevention/At Risk in the amount of \$261,711.00; Carryover for the program is \$12,724.00; local match is \$91,478.00 for a total program budget of \$365,913.00. Superintendent's report was given.

Board discussion followed. The group talked about the IASB convention. A workshop will be scheduled to review PPEL/SAVE projections and plan future projects.
