The supervisors reviewed bids previously opened for the Law En-

forcement Center Parking Lot Project #LEC-CO18(1)-18. Contractor bids were received as follows: Benson Construction, Cherokee, IA (Alternate A—no bid and Alternate B—\$76,135.00); Christensen Bros., Cherokee, IA (Alternate A—\$96,167.80 and Alternate B—\$124,323.30); Haselhoff Construction (Alternate A—\$85,627.00 and Alternate B—\$91,180.80); Wiese Construction, Cushing, IA (Alternate A—\$91,002.10 and Alternate B—\$93,602.24). An Attorney General opinion requested by Ryan Kolpin, County Attorney regarding bid letting for county supervisors was discussed.

Motion by Lundquist, seconded by Mummert to reject the low bid due to failure to follow bid proposal details and to accept a \$91,180.80 bid for Alternate B from Haselhoff Construction, Cherokee, IA, for the Law Enforcement Center Parking Lot Project #LEC-CO18(1)-18. Motion carried.

Motion by Mummert, seconded by Miller to authorize a change of position and wage increase for Andy Todd, from General Labor (\$21.61) to Operator (\$21.87), effective January 22, 2019. Motion carried.

Motion by Bush, seconded by Lundquist to authorize a change of position and wage increase for Garrett Ogren, from General Labor (\$21.61) to Operator (\$21.87), effective January 22, 2019. Motion carried.

Motion by Lundquist, seconded by Miller to authorize a \$21.87 wage authorization for Brian Smith, Secondary Roads Operator, effective January 17, 2019. Motion carried.

The following departments met with the supervisors to review their 2019/2020 budget requests:

Larry Walker, Weed Commissioner; Hedgie Brandt, Treasurer; Mark Murphy, Recorder; Chad Brown, Conservation; Stu Hogg, IT; Lisa Bringle, General Assistance; and William Gauthier and Wane Miller, Veteran Affairs Commission.

Dawn Mentzer, Rolling Hills Community Services Region, presented the region's budget for 2019/2020 and reported on legislative changes that now require counties to have zero cash carryover funds at the end of the fiscal year in their mental health funds. The county's contribution to the Rolling Hills Region for 2019/2010 will be \$441,292.00.

The supervisors provided committee reports, reviewed meeting schedules and continued reviewing the 2019/2020 budget.

There being no further business, Chairman Mongan adjourned the meeting at 11:45 a.m.
